To ensure this project supports training and employability goals locally, we have committed to a three-week work placement with Kyle McDonald, an S4 pupil at Duncanrig Secondary School to give him an introduction to construction. Kyle's Dad is a plasterer and has always had an interest in developing a similar career. The placement will give him training in site management as well as the opportunity to learn from our subcontractors. We will introduce Kyle to as many of our subcontractors as possible with the aim to securing further training or apprenticeship opportunities.

Engaging with our students

We have engaged with Glasgow Caledonian University, Lecturer in Construction Project Management, Mike Galbraith to offer a six-month work placement to a third year student. The placement will run from July to December, three months of which will be based on our Buchanan Street site. The lack of site management resource in construction is a very real concern. Training under-graduates with the aim to offer full time employment is an excellent way to grow and nurture talent from within.

Caring in our community

The harsh and sad reality is that our neighbours on Buchanan Street include the homeless community. We have the opportunity via this project to provide support to this community and have chosen to work with Homeless Project Scotland, a registered charity. We have reached out to our staff and supply chain to gather donations of food, sleeping bags and hygiene packs and we will be working with the charities Chairman, Colin McInnes to ensure our donations go to the people who need it most in Glasgow.
